PET WASTE

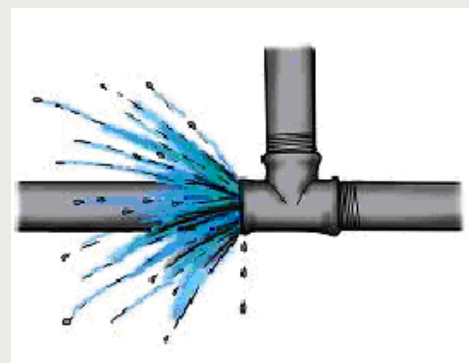
Pet waste continues to be a serious problem at Willow Creek. We ask that owners pick up after your dog every single time you take them out.

to maintenance you need to call the emergency maintenance department at **918-734-9796**. If you have an emergency relating to a crime or suspicion of a crime you need to call the police.



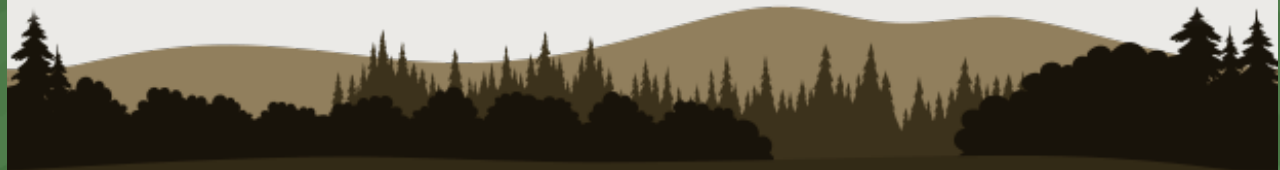
UNIT MANAGEMENT
